Application Guidelines for the 2024 NCAR Study Tour (Taiwan/ Australia) Organized by the National Center for Art Research

The National Center for Art Research (NCAR), established as part of the Independent Administrative Institution National Museums of Art, hosts the NCAR Study Tours for curators and researchers from Japan and abroad with the aim of building a diverse network among art experts in Japan and abroad. By hosting this program, we aim to deepen a mutual exchange of knowledgeable ideas and explore the possibilities for future collaborations and joint research among participants.

The 2024 NCAR Study Tour will focus on regional research in Taiwan and Australia and provide opportunities for art experts in Japan to explore art museums overseas in hopes of deepening the ongoing dialogue between art museums across borders. The participants will learn the museum's operation models, governance policies, and unique museum programs and activities through facility tours and meetings with curators. It is an exceptional opportunity for participants to think about the evolving roles of art museums nowadays, their relevant cultural policies, museum strategies at various levels, and how these trends can be reflected in Japan's art museum policies, as well as to develop a global network among art professionals.

1. Eligibility

Curators or researchers in Japan who are interested in the art museums in Taiwan or Australia and would like to conduct research related to the art scene of the area.

7. Eligibility requirements

- (a) Applicants who have an interest in art museum management and art scenes in Taiwan or Australia with a track record of activities and research in the field in which they specialize.
- (b) Understand the purpose of the study tour and participate in all itineraries.
- (c) Communicate adequately in English and strive for mutual understanding and exchange with the program participants.
- (d) Present their research topics and curatorial practices at the joint workshop (approximately 5 minutes per participant)
- (e) Have a concrete plan and intention to continuously utilize the results of the program in future activities and research.
- (f) Cooperate in attending symposiums and workshops when organized by NCAR in the future for the follow-up of this project and publicity activities for the program.
- (g) Not engage in any commercial or other for-profit activities during their stay in the program.
- (h) Submit a report (record of activities and research) after participating in the program.

9. Selection schedule

Selection (document review only) is scheduled in early August.
